

Dutch finance minister's skating tweet lands him on thin ice

THE HAGUE : The Dutch finance minister was on thin ice Friday for taking to a speed skating oval with one of the Netherlands' greatest Olympians. Finance Minister Wopke Hoekstra faced criticism Friday for breaching the country's tough coronavirus lockdown after posting a photo of himself on Twitter skating alongside Sven Kramer, the winner of four Winter Olympics gold medals in speed skating. "Sport is incredibly nice and also healthy," Hoekstra tweeted. It is also currently banned at indoor venues such as the Thialf oval where Hoekstra skated.

China considers new actions to lift flagging birthrate

China is considering additional measures to increase its flagging birthrate, more than four years after ending its controversial one-child policy.

For decades, China enforced strict controls on additional births in the name of preserving scarce resources for its burgeoning economy. But its plunging birthrate is now seen as a major threat to economic progress and social stability. On Thursday, the National Health Commission issued a statement saying it will conduct research to "further stimulate birth potential." It said the initiative will focus first on northeastern China, the country's former industrial heartland that has seen a major population decline as young people and families depart for better opportunities elsewhere.

The region comprising the three provinces of Liaoning, Jilin and Heilongjiang saw its total population decline for the seventh straight year

by 427,300 in 2019 over 2018. Authorities said last week that registered new births fell 15.3 per cent last year to just 10 million.

China abandoned its one-child-policy in 2016 to allow families to have an additional child. However, the move had only a temporary effect on the birthrate, with many couples citing the high cost of raising children and other economic and social barriers in deciding not to have more children.

Experts have been calling for further reforms because of economic concerns and the problem of an aging population.

China had a population of 1.34 billion in 2010 with an annual growth rate of 0.57 per cent, down from 1.07 per cent a decade earlier, statistics bureau data show.

The latest census was conducted in the second half of last year and the results have not yet been released.

A UN report says India is projected to overtake China as the world's most populous country by 2027.

Buckingham Palace has confirmed that Prince Harry and his wife, Meghan, will not be returning to royal duties, and Harry will give up his honorary mili-

itary titles. When Harry and Meghan stepped away from full-time royal life in early 2020 it was agreed the situation would be reviewed after a year.

The palace said Friday "that they will not be returning as working mem-

bers of 'The Royal Family'". It said Harry's appointment as captain general of the Royal Marines and with other military groups would revert to Queen Elizabeth II. The couple now live in California and are expecting their second child.

UK vows to share vaccines, but details thin as G-7 meets

Some of the world's wealthiest countries are promising to share coronavirus vaccines with the poorest, but details of when and how many remain scarce as leaders of the Group of Seven economic powers hold their first meeting of 2021 on Friday.

Prime Minister Boris Johnson of Britain, which holds the G-7 presidency this year, is meeting virtually with the leaders of France, Germany, Italy, Canada, Japan and the United States to discuss international challenges — chief among them the pandemic that has killed almost 2.5 million people around the world.

Wealthy nations have snapped up hundreds of millions of doses of vaccines against the virus, while some countries in the developing world have little or none.

Johnson, whose country has had almost 120,000 coronavirus deaths, will promise to give "the majority of any future surplus vaccines" to the UN-backed COVAX effort to vaccinate the world's most vulnerable people, and will encourage other G-7 countries to do



the same, the British government said.

But Foreign Office Minister James Cleverly said it was "difficult to say with any kind of certainty" when or how much Britain could donate.

"We're not really able to give with certainty either a timescale or the numbers involved," he told the BBC.

Anti-poverty group the One Campaign said Britain's promise was not enough. "The virus won't wait on us to be ready before it mutates, so we need to get these vaccines around the world as quickly as possible," said Romilly Greenhill, the group's UK director.

French President Emmanuel Macron gave a firmer target, saying Europe and the US should allocate up to 5 per cent of their current COVID-19 vaccine supplies to the poorest countries "very fast, so that people on the ground see it happening." In an interview with the Financial Times, Macron suggested Russia and China are engaged in a "war of influence over vaccines" by offering doses of their own products to some African nations.

America's G-7 allies are keen to impress President Joe Biden as his first major multilateral engagement since taking office.

Red Cross concerned over rebel offensive in central Yemen

The International Committee of the Red Cross in Yemen said Friday it was "extremely concerned" by the recent escalation of violence between Iran-backed Houthi rebels and government forces in the oil-rich Marib province.

"The ICRC urges all parties to the conflict to take every

possible measure to protect the civilians, their properties and all civilian essential infrastructures," the humanitarian agency tweeted.

The ICRC said it has provided medical supplies, including surgical kits, to hospitals treating the wounded, vowing to continue with the provision of medical needs.

Earlier this month, Houthi rebels renewed their attacks on Marib, the last anti-Houthi stronghold in central Yemen. Advances stalled however amid stiff resistance and airstrikes from the Saudi-led

coalition that opposes them. The latest bout of violence killed dozens of fighters, mostly Houthis, and sparked fears of a new humanitarian crisis.

Marib province has served as a sort of haven for around 1 million Yemenis who have fled Houthi offensives since the start of the war in 2014, according to UN figures.

The UN special envoy for Yemen Martin Griffiths told the UN Security Council Thursday that the conflict had taken "a sharp escalatory turn" after the Houthis launched the Marib offensive. "I have condemned this many times... and I repeat my call now: The attack on Marib must stop," Griffiths said. "It puts millions of civilians... at risk, especially with the fighting threatening to reach the camps for internally displaced persons." Yemen's war started in 2014 when the Houthis seized the capital, Sanaa, and much of the country's north. The Saudi-led, US-backed coalition intervened months later to dislodge the rebels and restore the internationally recognised government. The conflict has killed some 130,000 people and spanned the world's worst humanitarian disaster.

8 killed in Uganda mudslides

Eight people were killed and three others injured on Thursday in mudslides caused by heavy downpours in the western Ugandan district of Buhweju, police said on Friday.

Martial Tumusiime, regional police spokesman for Greater Bushenyi, a bordering district, told Xinhua by telephone on Friday that seven people were killed on the spot while the eighth person died in a nearby health center, the Xinhua news reported.

The three injured were rushed to nearby health centers for treatment.

Tumusiime said the dead included four members of the same family.

"They were taking shelter from one house after it started raining heavily. Unfortunately, the house was swept by mudslides," he said.

MOSCOW: India's strategic ties with Russia has very deep historic roots which provide stability and trust strong enough to navigate the complexities of the current world, Foreign Secretary Harsh Vardhan Shringla has said, as he sought to allay concerns that New Delhi is under pressure from the US to abandon military-technical cooperation with Moscow.

Six police officers suspended for misconduct during Capitol Hill riots; 29 under probe

A total of six US police officers have been suspended with pay and another 29 have been put under investigation over their conduct during the riots on Capitol Hill on January 6, according to a police department spokesperson.

"Acting Chief Yogananda Pittman has directed that any member of her department whose behaviour is not in keeping with the Department's Rules of Conduct will face appropriate discipline," said police spokesperson John Stolnis, as

quoted by CNN. Last month, CNN had reported that the Capitol police were investigating at least 10 officers, while two were suspended.

According to Tim Ryan, a member of the House of Representatives, one of the suspended officers took a selfie with a protester, while another officer was wearing a hat with then-President Donald Trump's slogan "Make America Great Again." On Tuesday, House

Speaker Nancy Pelosi said the US Congress would establish a special commission to probe Capitol Hill attack. On January 6, a group of then US President Donald Trump's sup-

ports stormed the US Capitol building. The unrest took place af-

ter Trump urged his supporters to protest what he claims is a stolen presidential election. Five people — four protesters and a police officer — were killed in the riots.
