The minister had responded, saying, "On the job. @GoI_MeitiY takes its responsibility to keep Internet Safe and Trusted and Intermediaries accountable for the content and due diligence very seriously".

Sources said the government had identified 73 Twitter handles, 4 pieces of YouTube content, and 1 Instagram game.

Accordingly, 73 Twitter handles have been suspended, 4 YouTube content and the particular Instagram game have been removed.

The Delhi Police had registered a case after coming across a morphed video of a cabinet committee meeting wherein some persons tried to show that the meeting was against the Sikh community, officials had said on Friday.

The Centre, last year, had introduced stringent rules for social media platforms to make them more accountable to end-users in one of the world's largest internet markets.

'Lander, rover of China's Chang'e 4 probe completes 1,003.9 m of travel on far side of moon'

YUTU-2, THE LANDER and rover of China's Chang'e 4 lunar probe which scripted history in 2019 when it made the first-ever soft landing on the far side of the moon, has travelled 1,003.9 metres of the region and captured an obscure intriguing image of a

mysterious object, the official media reported on Saturday. The distance covered by Yutu-2, or Jade Rabbit-2, was 1,003.9 metres as of Thursday midnight, the Xinhua news agency reported, citing the Lunar Exploration and Space Programme Centre of the China National Space Administration. The Chang'e-4 probe was launched on December 8, 2018.

Tennis superstar Djokovic had Covid-19 in December: Lawyers

LAWYERS FOR NOVAK Djokovic filed court documents in his challenge against deportation from Australia that showed the tennis star contracted Covid-19 last month, the *Australian Broadcasting Corp* (ABC) reported. The No. 1-ranked Djokovic was denied entry at the Melbourne airport late on Wednesday after border officials cancelled his visa for failing to meet its entry requirement that all non-citizens be fully vaccinated for Covid-19.

Djokovic was given a medical exemption backed by the Victoria state government and Australian Open organisers based on information he supplied to two independent medical panels. But it has since emerged that the medical exemption, allowed for people who tested positive for the coronavirus in the previous six months, was deemed invalid by border authorities. Djokovic is in an immigration deten-

The ABC reported that in the documents filed Saturday, Djokovic's lawyers said Tennis Australia on January 1 granted the 34-year-old Serbian player a "medical exemption from Covid vac-

cination" on the grounds that he had recently recovered from the coronavirus. The exemption certification said the date of Djokovic's first positive test was December 16, 2021, and that he had not had a fever or respiratory symptoms in the past 72 hours. The court submission said Djokovic received a document from Australia's department of home affairs saying that his travel declaration had been assessed and that his responses indicated that he met the requirements for quarantine-free arrival in Australia.

India reports 1,41,986 new Covid cases, 285 deaths

INDIA SAW A single-day rise of 1,41,986 new coronavirus cases, raising the tally to 3,53,68,372, which included 3,071 cases of Omicron variant reported across 27 states and union territories so far, the Union Health Ministry said on Saturday. Of the 3,071 cases of Omicron variant, 1,203 have recovered or migrated, according to the data updated by the ministry at 8 am.

Maharashtra has recorded the maximum number of 876 Omicron variant cases, followed by Delhi at 513, Karnataka 333, Rajasthan 291, Kerala 284 and Gujarat 204.

A total of 1,41,986 new coronavirus infections were reported in a day, the highest in around 222 days. The active Covid cases have increased to 4,72,169, the highest in around 187 days, according to the data. The death toll has climbed to 4,83,463 with 285 fresh fatalities, it stated.

A total of 1,52,734 new infections were reported on May 31 last year.

The active Covid cases

have increased to 4,72,169, comprising 1.34 % of the total infections. The national Covid-19 recovery rate has decreased to 97.30%, the health ministry said. An increase of 1,00,806 cases has been recorded in the active Covid-19 caseload in a span of 24 hours, it said. The daily positivity rate was recorded at 9.28%, while the weekly positivity rate was recorded at 5.66%, the ministry said. The number of people who have recuperated from Covid-19 surged to 3,44,12,740, while the case fatality rate was recorded at 1.37%, it said. The cumulative doses administered in the country so far under the nationwide Covid-19 vaccination drive has exceeded 150.06 crore, the ministry said. India's Covid-19 tally had crossed the 20-lakh mark on August 7, 2020, 30 lakh on August 23, 40 lakh on September 5 and 50 lakh on September 16. It went past 60 lakh on September 28, 70 lakh on October 11, crossed 80 lakh on October 29, 90 lakh on November 20 and surpassed the one-crore mark on December 19, 2020.

Covid: WHO pushes for strict social measures

THE WORLD HEALTH Organization called for strict implementation of public health and social measures as Covid-19 cases surge in most countries of the South-East Asia Region. It also said though the Omicron variant of coronavirus may appear to be less severe, it should not be dismissed as 'mild'.

All preventive and protective measures must be implemented with full earnestness by one and all, Dr Poonam Khetrapal Singh, Regional Director, WHO South-East Asia Region, said. "Authorities must implement situation-specific measures to arrest the further spread of the virus. People must adhere to these measures. Masks, hand hygiene, cough etiquette, ventilation, and physical distancing is an absolute must," she said in a statement. Singh said Omicron variant should not be dismissed as 'mild'.

Emerging as the most predominant variant, this highly infectious variant is already overwhelming health systems around the world. Globally we are seeing hospitalisation and deaths from Omicron, she added. "We must also not forget that not every Covid-19 case is an Omicron infection. Other variants, including Delta, are also circulating, which, as we know, cause severe infections and deaths," the WHO regional director said.
