# 21 check posts, 1340 polling booths in dist to be monitored through webcasting

In view of the Lok Sabha elections 2024, 21 selected checkposts and 1340 polling stations of Indore district will be monitored through webcasting. SST teams have also been deployed at these centres.

In order to conduct free and fair polls, strict arrangements are being made to make the security more tight. This was informed by additional collector and deputy district election officer Rajendra Raghuvanshi here on Friday. Three check post sites of Depalpur assembly constituency Bahirampur near the railway track, Toll Naka Medhwada and Sagor Road Kalibillaud will be monitored by SST police team and webcasting. Similarly, 2 check posts of Bada Ganpati and Aerodrome (Depalpur Road) of Assembly Constituency Indore-1, near Chandragupta Maurya Square (M.R. 10) under Assembly Constituency

Indore-2, near Chandan Nagar Police Station in Assembly Constituency Indore-4. D-Mart and Kesharbagh Chowki R.T.O, near, checkpost Star Chauraha (M.R. 10) and Gol Chauraha (Azad Nagar) in Assembly Constituency Indore-5, a total of 5 check posts (check points) in Assembly Constituency Mhow in which Gram Panchayat Pigdambar A.B. Road, Talai Naka Simrol, Bhicholi Phata, Datoda Chowkhi Dhani and Jamgate (Jamkhurd).

Similarly, in Rau assembly constituency, Rau Circle near IIM Toll Naka and Umrikheda (Khandwa Road near Chameli Devi College), 4 check posts of Sanwer assembly constituency including Chimli Fata Ujain Road, Old Toll Tax A.B Road Kshipra, Shivpura Kheda Chandravatiganj and at Muhada Ghat near Hanuman Temple SST team will be deployed. All these check posts will be monitored through webcasting.

# Diesel scam worth crores of rupees comes to light

A diesel scam worth crores of rupees came to light in Nagar Palika Parishad in Balaghat.

Chief municipal officer Nishant Shrivastava who has brought the scam to light is sifting through the files in connection with the scam.

The scam came to light when a bill worth Rs 40 lakh was put up before him for approval.

He also came to know

that a sum of Rs 20 lakh was being spent on vehicles of the civic body every month.

When he smelt a rat, he sifted through the log books, and came to know that lakhs of rupees were spent every month on diesel.

When Shrivastava decided not to spend so much money on diesel, he reduced expenses which came down to Rs 8 lakh a month.

Shrivastava handed over the files to the collector re-

questing him to probe the case.

Chairperson of Nagar Palika Parishad Bharti Thakur sent a memorandum to the collector for probing the case.

Legislator Anubha Mujare said that the scam brought to light by Shrivastava had been going on for many years. As a result, the civic body incurred a heavy loss, she said. She said that the Economic Offences Wing should have been handed over the case.

# State cyber cell cautions against crimes

The state cyber cell has released an advisory to caution people about different types of cybercrimes.

### Cheating by exploiting fear of children's arrest

Currently, a unique cybercrime trend involves deceiving people into sending money by claiming that their children, studying in a distant city, have been arrested by the police for some offence.

Often, children are unable to answer calls due to their busy schedules with college or coaching, leading parents to believe that their child is indeed in trouble.

Fraudsters also leverage technologies like AI to mimic children's voices during phone calls, further convincing parents of the authenticity of the situation, prompting them to transfer large sums of money to the perpetrators.

### Precautions:

Avoid answering calls, WhatsApp calls/video calls, or Telegram calls from unknown numbers.

Refrain from trusting unknown individuals and refrain from disclosing information about your

family and children.

Exercise caution when someone claiming to be a police officer or lawyer contacts you; verify their credentials before taking any action.

In case of any cybercrime incident, promptly report it to the nearest police station or through www.cybercrime.gov.in or the toll-free Cyber Crime Helpline number 1930.

### Child pornography

In the current digital landscape, involvement in any activity related to child pornography, including creation, storage, receipt, download, exchange, distribution, browsing, searching, or promotion, constitutes a criminal offence under various sections of the IT Act, IPC, and POCSO Act. The government actively monitors such activities and takes strict action against offenders through the State Cyber Police of Madhya Pradesh.

### Precautions:

Avoid joining any social media groups (Facebook, WhatsApp, Telegram, etc.) involved in the exchange of child pornography.

Refrain from visiting websites or installing applications containing child pornography material.

### Digital arrest fraud perpetrated in the name of investigation agencies

In recent times, a specific type of cybercrime involves fraudsters contacting individuals via calls or WhatsApp, often originating from +92 (Pakistani) numbers or other international numbers (+91). The perpetrators impersonate officers from investigation agencies such as NCB, CBI, ED, NIA, etc., falsely claiming that a parcel in the recipient's name containing narcotics has been seized. Sometimes, they demand money for court fees, bail, or for removing the recipient's name from the case.

### Precautions:

Avoid answering calls, WhatsApp calls, video calls, or Telegram calls from unknown numbers, especially those starting with +92.

Indian law does not mandate digital arrests, so do not isolate yourself based on someone's advice or fear.

Refrain from sharing personal information such as bank account details, Aadhaar, etc., with anyone.

Do not transfer money to unfamiliar accounts.

No legitimate organisation advises depositing or saving personal funds in any government account.

# Welder falls from height while working, dies

The work on the first phase of Indore Metro is going on at a fast pace between Gandhi Nagar and Robot Square, while the contract for the elevated corridor from Robot Square to Palasia Square has also been awarded and now the work will be started in the central area.

# Girl going to buy items for Dashamata puja, killed in road mishap

**Indore:** A 14-year-old girl was killed after a speeding motorcycle hit her two-wheeler from behind on Thursday. The accident occurred in the Sagor Kuti area when she was going to buy items for Dashamata Pooja with her uncle from the market. She was sitting on the pillion seat. The bike rider fled from the scene after the incident. According to the police, the deceased was identified as Gudiya daughter of Dinesh, a resident of Kali Billod in Depalpur. She was a student of VII standard. Her father is a labourer. She was going with her uncle Dilip who was riding the two-wheeler to the market to buy items for Dashamata Pooja when another motorcycle hit them from behind. She was taken to the hospital but doctors declared her brought dead.

# Christian Aussie citizen cremated on family's request

Despite being a Christian, a 53-year-old Australian citizen, who was found dead in a city hotel, was laid to rest with Hindu Vedic rituals on Friday, with the consent of his grieving family.

The deceased, Gavin Andrew Bailey, a resident of Japan and an Australian citizen had arrived in the city on a business trip on February 15 and was found dead in his hotel room in Lasudia police station jurisdiction on April 2. His family members reside in Japan and were informed

about the incident.

ACP Vijay Nagar Krishna Lalchandani informed Free Press that Andrew's wife, Masami Bailey, gave written consent to the police stating that 'he should be cremated in Indore and his remains and belongings should be sent to them as they could not come to India immediately'.

An autopsy examination was conducted, and the body was then cremated at Meghdoot crematorium around 3 pm. The expenses of the cremation were borne by the police department. However, the department

will charge for transporting the belongings of the deceased to the family in Japan. An official from the Australian High Commission in India, Prashant, ACP Lalchandani and TI Lasudia police station Taresh Kumar Soni were present during the cremation ceremony.

Preliminary investigations suggest that he died due to cardiac arrest. However, Andrew's viscera samples have been preserved in case they are needed for further investigation.

The deceased had arrived in India during the last week of January and had also visited Kochi and Ahmedabad before arriving in Indore. He was an employee at Toshiba Company and had come to the city for a solar energy project-related assignment.

The police also took action against the hotel management under prohibitory sections for not informing them about his stay, as it is mandatory for hotel staff to inform the police about the stay of any foreign citizens in their hotel.

# IDA sold properties worth Rs 850 crore in last fiscal

Taking advantage of the real estate boom the Indore Development Authority sold property worth Rs 850 crore in the last fiscal.

The Registration Department earned revenue of more than Rs 100 crore from registries of these properties. The properties sold include plots, flats, shops and other properties. If we look at the records of the last 5 years, properties worth Rs 308.64 crore were sold in 2019-20, but in

2020-21 it came down to Rs 250.67 crore, because of Covid. This figure increased to Rs 438.35 crore in 2021-22. While properties worth Rs 499.60 crore were sold in 2022-23, this figure reached Rs 850 crore in 2023-24, breaking all previous records.

At the same time, the authority has spent about Rs 430 crore on ongoing projects and its TPS schemes in the last fiscal. Principal secretary Neeraj Mandloi (Urban Development and Housing Department) who came to Indore on Wednesday, first reviewed the ongoing projects of the Indore Municipal Corporation and then of the Indore Development Authority and also gave necessary guidelines regarding pending projects.

# SGSITS students make digital stethoscope at 1/10th cost

Students of Shri Govindram Seksaria Institute of Technology and Science (SGSITS) researched and made digital stethoscopes at one-tenth of the usual price. A digital stethoscope usually costs around Rs 20,000 and the students prepared one for less than Rs 2,000. In fact, if produced in bulk, the price can easily be brought down to Rs 1,500, as per the team of developers. The team of students includes Narayan Chouhan, Sandeep Sharma, Naman Jain, Naman Sahu, and Khyati Shastri. The team was guided by IT department head Dr Lalit Purohit, in-charge professor Pooja Gupta, and biomedical department head Dr PP Bansod with Vinay Manurkar. The students explained how the stethoscope would help medicine in India:

### Why digital stethoscope?

Sound levels with acoustic stethoscopes are rather low. The digital stethoscope addresses this concern by electronically enhancing bodily noises. The electronic transmission of sound signals enables wireless connectivity and facilitates noise reduction.
